## Visa Processing Times

Travel is a bit more challenging at the moment, as airlines, airports and travel document processing centres get back to speed and deal with more interest than usual.

If you are planning to travel and teach in the UK in early 2023, you need to apply for your visa in good time to get it back before you leave. Check your passport is in date and has at least 12 months before it expires and if you need a Youth Mobility Scheme visa take advantage of the ability to apply 6 months before you plan to arrive.
