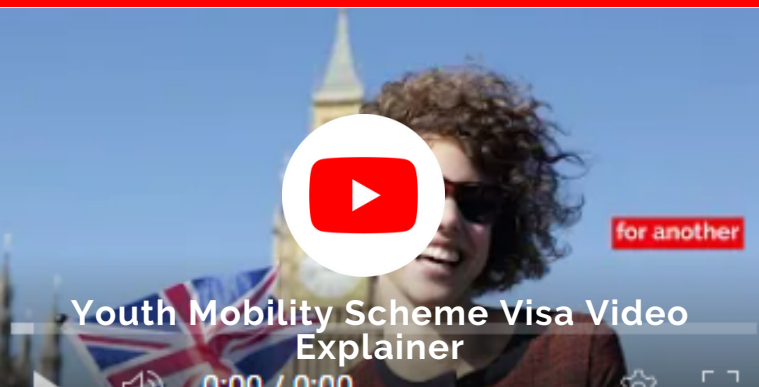

The Youth Mobility Scheme Visa

If you are an Aussie, New Zealander or Canadian citizen between 18 and 35 years with no children and a no major criminal offences, you are allowed to apply and gain a Youth Mobility Scheme Visa. The visa is initially for 2 years, and you can only have it once. At the end of the two years you can apply to extend the visa for a further year. The visa is currently £259 and you also have to pay two years of the UK's Immigration Health Surcharge, which is essentially 2 years of health cover so you are bulk billed for Dr visits, hospital stays, ambulance and most dental. It is £1552 for the two years.
